



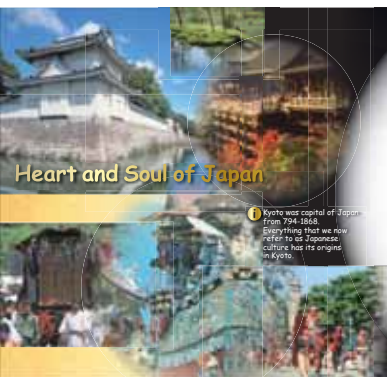

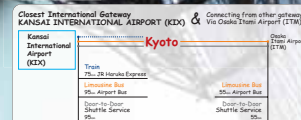

Connecting from other gateways:
Via Osaka Shinjitsu Airport (ITM)

Tokyo Gateway
Narita (NRT) & Haneda (HND) international airports connect with Kyoto via a Shinkansen train to Osaka and then to Kyoto via the Shinkansen bullet train (2.5 hours).

Nagoya Gateway
Ginza (NGO) connects with Kyoto by train using the Shinkansen bullet train (2.5 hours).

Fukuoka Gateway
Fukuoka International Airport connects with Kyoto by train using the Shinkansen bullet train (3.0 hours).
