Subsidy for Costs Associated with Holding Large-Scale International Conventions

Large-Scale International Convention Subsidy

Target: C - International Conventions/Congresses

Upper Limit: 10,000,000 yen

Required Duration: 3 days or more

Participants required: 500 or more participants

Non-Japanese participants: at least a total of 100 non-Japanese participants from 3 or more countries

Application Period: If possible, please inquire before the host city is decided.

Subsidy for Costs Associated with Attracting Large-Scale International Conventions

Subsidy for Attracting Large-Scale International Conventions

Target: C - International Conventions/Congresses

Target expenses details: Cost of public promotion, printing and binding, meeting venue hiring etc.

Upper Limit: 1,000,000 yen

Required Duration: 3 days or more

Participants required: 500 or more participants

Non-Japanese participants: At least a total of 100 non-Japanese participants from 3 or more countries

Application Period: Must be before the host city is decided.

Subsidy for costs associated with Holding Small- and Medium-sized MICE Events

Small and Medium-sized MICE Event Subsidy

Target: M - Corporate meetings, I - Incentive tours, C - Domestic & International Conferences/Congresses

Upper Limit: Small-sized events: 200,000 yen, Medium-sized events: 500,000 yen

Participants required:

M, I, C 50-199 participants (small-sized) / M, I 200 or more participants (medium-sized) / C 200-499 Participants (medium-sized)

Non-Japanese Residents: Not required

Application Period: Any time after the fiscal year the event will be held in begins.

Can be used in combination with other subsidies if it is an international meeting, incentive or convention. Up to 300,000 yen support for cultural programs like traditional dance or Kyoto handicraft products.*

Full cost support for cultural programs like dance or Kyoto handicraft products

Kyoto Culture for Meetings & Events Subsidy

Target: M, I, C, and Alumni meetings (Class reunions, business alumni meetings, etc.)

Eligible expenses: (1 and 2 can be used in combination)

1. Costs of Maiko and Geiko performances (Kyoto Geisha), Taiko drums, tea ceremony, kimono wearing, sake barrel opening ceremonies, etc.
2. Costs of traditional Kyoto-made handicraft souvenirs for participants, workshop tours and handicraft experiences/classes.

Upper Limit: 300,000 yen

Duration: 1 day or more

(At least 70 percent of participants must be staying at least 1 night in Kyoto City. (Alumni association meetings exempt.))

Participants required: M, I, C: 30 People or more, Alumni meetings: 100 people or more.

(At least 50% of participants must reside outside of Kyoto City.)

Non-Japanese Participants: Not required

Application Period: Any time after the fiscal year the event will be held in begins
